Summary Annual Report for Trinity Health Corporation Welfare Benefit Plan

This is a summary of the annual report of the Trinity Health Corporation Welfare Benefit Plan, Plan #504 (the "Plan"), for the period January 1, 2006 to December 31, 2006. This Plan was established as of January 1st, 2006 and consolidates and amends certain other welfare benefit plans and programs sponsored by Trinity Health Corporation. The annual report has been filed with the Pension and Welfare Benefits Administration, U.S. Department of Labor, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Trinity Health has committed itself to pay certain health care and dental claims incurred under the terms of the Plan for active and retired participants enrolled in the Plan.

Insurance Information

The Plan has agreements with several health maintenance organizations/preferred provider organizations to pay medical claims incurred under the terms of the Plan.

Basic Financial Statement

The value of Plan assets as of December 31, 2006, after subtracting the liabilities of the Plan, was \$109,772,878 compared to \$48,511,466 as of December 31, 2005. Total benefit obligations of the Plan were \$186,397,999 as of December 31, 2006 compared to \$182,306,117 as of December 31, 2005. During the Plan year, the Plan had total income of \$424,496,132 including employer contributions of \$362,175,971, employee contributions of \$57,750,288 and earnings from investments of \$4,569,873.

Plan expenses were \$363,234,720. These expenses included \$10,685,496 in administrative expenses, \$113,599,338 in expenses to insurance carriers, and \$238,949,886 in expenses to provide benefits directly to participants and beneficiaries.

The charge to cover copying costs given above does not include a charge for the copying of these portions of the report because these portions are furnished without charge.

You also have the legally protected right to examine the annual report at the main office of the Plan, 34605 Twelve Mile Rd., Farmington Hills, MI 48331, and at the U.S. Department of Labor in Washington, D.C., or to obtain a copy from the U.S. Department of Labor upon payment of copying costs.
