

SUMMARY OF MATERIAL MODIFICATIONS TO THE TRINITY HEALTH MEDICAL PLAN

This Summary of Material Modifications (“SMM”) describes changes to the Trinity Health Self Insured Medical Plans (“Plan”) effective July 1, 2010. This SMM modifies and revises the Plan’s Benefits-at-a-Glance / Appendix / Summary / Summary of Benefits section of the Summary Plan Description (“SPD”).

Prescription Drugs

The **PRESCRIPTION DRUG** section of the **BENEFITS-AT-A-GLANCE / APPENDIX / SUMMARY / SUMMARY OF BENEFITS** is revised to read as follows:

Effective July 1, 2010, CVS Caremark will become the new Pharmacy Benefit Manager (PBM) for Trinity Health associates and retirees with medical coverage through Blue Cross Blue Shield of Michigan, Aetna, Priority Health or NGS American.

The **Claims Administrator** (CVS Caremark) is responsible for pharmacy claim processing for initial claims determination as well as for the final decision for any appeal filed in response to an adverse benefit determination. The **Claims Administrator** is responsible for notifying you of the adverse benefit determination, based on the type of claim, as well as reviewing any appeal you may make.
