***Prenatal Pediatric Visit**

A visit with a pediatrician *before* the baby is born is recommended for first-time parents, those with high-risk pregnancies, and parents who wish to discuss other common newborn issues, such as feeding, circumcision, etc.

****Suggested Screenings, Birth to 5 Years**

Hereditary / metabolic screening: 2 days of age (can be administered anytime from newborn through 1 month).

Hematocrit or hemoglobin: 9 months.

Urinalysis: 5 years.

Vision and hearing: tested as necessary at discretion of physician.

Screenings for patients at risk: at discretion of physician, TB cholesterol, and lead screenings (lead screenings should be done at ages 1, 2, and 3 in high-risk geographical areas).

Dental exam: 3 years (can be performed anytime between 1 and 3 years).
