Summary Annual Report for Trinity Health Corporation Welfare Benefit Plan

This is a summary of the annual report of the Trinity Health Corporation Welfare Benefit Plan (the "Plan"), EIN 35-1443425, Plan No. 505, for the plan year January 1, 2008 to December 31, 2008. The annual report has been filed with the Pension and Welfare Benefits Administration, U.S. Department of Labor, as required under the Employee Retirement Income and Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Insurance Information

The Plan has a contract with the Metropolitan Life Insurance Company, Unum Life Insurance Company of America, United HealthCare Insurance Company, and Hyatt Group Legal Plans to pay certain claims incurred under the terms of the Plan. The total premiums paid for the Plan year ending December 31, 2008 were \$23,760,652.

The charge to cover copying costs given above does not include a charge for the copying of these portions of the report because these portions are furnished without charge.

You also have the legally protected right to examine the annual report at the main office of the plan, 34605 Twelve Mile Rd., Farmington Hills, MI 48331, and at the U.S. Department of Labor in Washington, D.C. or to obtain a copy from the U.S. Department of Labor upon payment of copying costs.
